Tumen - Namyang Crossing - This remote border post connects the Chinese city of Tumen in Jilin Province with the North Korean town of Namyang in North Hamgyong Province across the friendship road bridge on the Tumen River. A nearby rail connection also connects these towns, but is for freight trains only.

The Friendship Bridge linking North Korea and Russia. There is one crossing on the North Korea-Russia border: the Friendship Bridge over the Tumen River, 800 metres (2,600 ft) southwest of the train station in Khasan, Russia. On the North Korean side, the border train station is at Tumangang.

Located on the border with China, in the northeast corner of North Korea, is the Namyang-Tumen crossing (42.949050° 129.849236°) in North Hamgyong Province. This crossing consists of both the Tumen railroad bridge (Tumen-gyo) and, 600 meters to the northeast, the Tumen Road Bridge (Tumen-taegyo).
