How Adjust Rangefinder, Unmount and Mount Lens In Argus C3 ...

The rangefinder mechanism is quite unconventional, but when one considers that it derives from the Argus C's uncoupled rangefinder, it makes sense, as it is similar in anatomy to many external or uncoupled viewfinders. There is a ring-shaped dial around the left-hand rangefinder window (right-hand from the photographer's perspective) that has a range scale in feet marked on it--the shortest labeled distance is 3 ft, and the longest after infinity is 100 ft.

The original Argus C was equipped with an uncoupled rangefinder which required the user to manually rotate the lens barrel to match the rangefinder reading, while the C2 coupled the rangefinder to the lens to allow one-step focusing. The C3 added built-in flash synchronization but was otherwise identical to the C2.

The Argus C4 is a 35mm fixed lens, couple rangefinder manufactured by Argus, Inc. In the 1950s, Argus sold over 300,000 Argus C4 35mm rangefinder cameras. It had one of the best implementations of a viewfinder with superimposed rangefinder, an easy film load concept and a hot shoe for attaching and connecting a flash without cable. It had a modern design, but no interchangeable lenses.
