A common problem is a worn out, stretched, or maladjusted shift linkage. A stretched linkage can be caused by a damaged engine or transmission mount. An external linkage can wear out or become loose and maladjusted, causing the transmission to jump out of gear. Look for rust and binding.

With a manual transmission, the most common red flag is grinding when you shift. If it happens after you engage the clutch and shift, it could also be a sign of a faulty clutch. Either way, you need to get it checked. With an automatic transmission, you're more likely to find it's hard to get into gear when you first take off.

When the gear shift handle is sloppy, it is just a matter of the ball end being loose in its socket. A top-loader transmission uses a gear shift handle that has a spring under the plate, and it pushes down on a ball at the bottom of

On manual transmissions, a failing or worn out gear synchronizer may be the culprit. If your gears aren't synchronized properly, it won't shift gears smoothly. The engine control unit (ECU) needs to be updated. Modern vehicles are as much about technology as they are about mechanics.

If the gear lever does not slot surely into

a gear and feels rubbery then it's a problem with the bushes at the bottom of the gear lever. This could have become hard and brittle, which will make it tough to change gears. Also check the gear linkage mechanism. There are two kinds of gear linkage mechanisms - cable shift or rod shift.

Troubleshooting hard to shift gears, causes and remedies

If the shift lever is hard to move from one gear to another you want to start off by inspecting the clutch operation as well as the shift linkage. Incorrect fluid selection can cause hard shifting manual transmission problems. Internal components like shift rails, shifting forks and synchronizers can cause hard shifting also.

point. This will either be your cable screwing into the transmission housing or an electronic sensor bolted to the housing.

How to Diagnose Automatic Transmission Problems

Worn shift cables, loose linkage and bent shift rails are also very common.

Bearings: When bearings are worn and begin to bind or offer resistance hard shifting occurs. A manual transmission uses needle roller bearings between the driven gears and the main shaft they spin on.
