Plant Identification - Illinois Native Plant Society

Sassafras albidum – a native to Missouri, is a medium-sized tree with all-season interest. Clusters of small yellow flowers can almost cover the tree in early spring. The fragrant mitten-shaped leaves are bright green. In the fall, colors range from deep orange to scarlet and purple.

Grayhead coneflower grows well in full sun to light shade, reaching heights of 3 to 5 feet. The clumps of basal leaves stay green late into the fall and reappear early each spring.
