Antabuse (Disulfiram) as a Drinking Deterrent. Antabuse (disulfiram) was the first medicine approved for the treatment of alcohol abuse and alcohol dependence. It works by causing a severe adverse reaction when someone taking the medication consumes alcohol. Most people who take it will vomit after a drink of alcohol.

### 3 Medications for Alcoholism Treatment

According to the National Survey on Drug Use and Health (NSDUH), more than 2.4 million people age 12 or older received substance use treatment in 2017 for alcohol use alone. 8 Many of the individuals who are treated for alcoholism and alcohol abuse often seek outside help from treatment centers and therapy sessions.
