The first step to treatment is to talk with a healthcare provider to arrange an evaluation. For a PTSD diagnosis, a specific event must have triggered the symptoms. Because the event was distressing, children may not want to talk about the event, so a health provider who is highly skilled in talking with children and families may be needed.

Psychotherapy, or "talk therapy," is the mainstay of mental health treatment at Children's. Psychotherapy will teach a child with PTSD specific coping strategies, including learning how to: identify feelings of fear manage fear and anxiety with relaxation techniques and self-soothing activities

Play therapy can be used to treat young children with PTSD who are not able to deal with the trauma more directly. The therapist uses games, drawings, and other techniques to help the children process their traumatic memories.

Standardized screening and assessment instruments have been developed for caregivers of this age group, with both self-administered checklists and diagnostic interviews (reviewed in 18). Evidence-based treatments for PTSD, such as cognitive behavioral therapy, are effective (7,19,20).
